




- 102 Faces of Oahu**

Welcome to the New Pearl Harbor Visitor Center. To gain the full experience of your USS Arizona Memorial tour and its museums, purchase our self-guided narrated audio tour. With an inspiring narration by Jamie Lee Curtis, National Park Service historians and Pearl Harbor Survivors, you'll be provided with an enriching, educational and patriotic experience you'll never forget.

Put on the headset and use the map as a guide through 28 locations from the Visitor Center to the USS Arizona Memorial and museums. For your convenience, the Narrated Tour stops can be done in any order. Enter the numbers located on various plaques around the park then press the green "Play" button.


